The University of Winchester has a long and well established track record for providing high quality education. It is a small university of around 9,000 students studying at both undergraduate and graduate level on a wide range of program. The campus is delightfully situated on a wooded hillside overlooking the beautiful cathedral city of Winchester and is just a 10-minute walk into the city center. It also has an extensive modern library, new and well-equipped IT Centres, active Student Union and great sports facilities. Winchester is located only 1.5 hours away by train from both London and Oxford.

<b>Departments Available for Exchange Students:</b>	Classical Studies, Criminology, Creative Writing, English, Film Studies, Forensics, Geography (CLEN at StFX), Media Studies, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, Sport Studies (HKIN at StFX), Religion

<b>Course Requirements:</b>	Exchange students are expected to take 60 UK credits per semester of study. 60 UK credits are equal to 15 credits at StFX. 10 UK credits are equal to 3 credits at StFX.
<b>Course Restrictions:</b>	Incoming students can choose modules (courses) across all academic areas, subject to approval. Most of Winchester's degree courses are 3 years in duration. When selecting modules (courses), you need to be aware of the academic level to ensure you are studying at a level in keeping with your studies at home. 3rd year StFX students will typically choose year 1 or year 2 modules. Year 3 modules would be equivalent to 4th year courses at StFX.

## ACCOMMODATIONS

<b>Type of Accommodation:</b>	On Campus Residence and Off Campus Housing

<b>Cost:</b>	£295 – £560 per month. <a href="#">Link</a> (Equivalent to approximately \$510 – \$965 CAD.)
<b>Details:</b>	<p>Winchester offers self-catered rooms (no meal-plan), catered rooms (meal plan included), or off-campus housing options. All on-campus residences include utilities, WIFI, 24 hour security, bedroom furniture, en-suites in most rooms, bike lockers for hire, contents insurance, and cleaning service for communal areas.</p> <p>Self-catered rooms can be rented for one semester or the full year. Full year contracts include the Christmas and Easter vacations and there is no requirement for residents to move out during those times.</p> <p>Catered rooms include the cost of 14 meals per week, and can only be rented for one semester. Due to this, students must move out during the Christmas vacation (for Fall semester) or Easter vacation (for Winter semester).</p>

## OTHER COSTS

<b>Health Insurance:</b>	<p>All StFX students are required to purchase travel health insurance for the duration of their time abroad. <a href="#">Link</a></p> <p>Additionally, full-year exchange students to the U.K. will be required to pay an <a href="#">immigration health surcharge</a> (£470) as part of their student visa application fee.</p>

<b>Visa:</b>	<p>One semester exchange students will need a <a href="#">visitors visa</a>. (£95)</p> <p>Full-year exchange students will need a <a href="#">student visa</a>.
