 - A campaign will be launched over the coming year to support positive citizenship and will include messaging to support anti-racism, sexualized violence, safer and more responsible substance use, mental health (Being Xaverian campaign)
 - The modules You Belong@X (anti- racism), Safer Socializing@X, and Consent is Visible@X have been introduced to new students. The training has been made available to managers of student employees and Student Union and employees and they have also been encouraged to give preference when hiring to students who have completed the Xaverian Community Foundations Certificate. athletes were required to complete the anti-racism module. The modules will be followed with discussion-based programing in residence carried out by trained student facilitators through the year. Returning students will be invited to complete the modules
